Final Round

■ Judging Methods (Excerpt from the KIFC's Judging Regulations)

After the evaluation of all performances in the final round, the prize winners shall be determined as follows:

- (1) The final round will be judged based on a point system with a 100-point scale. And, each jury member shall attribute to each contestant a mark of integer between 75 and 100 points.
- (2) The contestant with the highest total number of points attributed by jury members is the highest ranked contestant.
- (3) In the event that two or more competitors have the same total point, they shall be placed in the same rank.
- (4) After the order of the highest ranked contestants from 1 to 6 is placed in accordance with the above mentioned (2) and (3), jury members will determine a prize to which the highest ranked contestants shall be awarded. Then, prizes for the second through sixth ranked contestants shall be determined at the same manner.
